Meeting Items

- 1) **Check Detail Report:** The report was present.
- 2) **2025 Audit:** The audit is scheduled for the week of June 8, 2026, with the sewer portion scheduled for May 27, 2026. Auditors gave Danielle Robison a long list of items to gather in order to prepare.
- 3) **Fire Tax:** Danielle Robison has completed some research for fire tax options of \$500,000 and 1 million dollars. York County advised that they would need millage data, as soon as possible even though it is not required until December. Garrett Strouse advised that residents are able to apply for a rebate with the Fire Department to be reimbursed for their

fire tax. He also stated that the funds are limited on what they can be used for. This will be placed on the agenda for our next council meeting.

- 4) **Summer Committee Meetings:** Danielle Robison proposed eliminating the Committee Meetings for June, July, and August with the option of adding topics to regular meetings. This will be added to the next Council Meeting.
- 5) **Pocket Park:** Public Works will buy top soil, flower pots and flowers to add to the park, not exceeding \$1500. This job can be completed in about 2-3 days. Brent Auchey and Danielle Robison will bring their contracts to the next council meeting to discuss anything else that needs to be completed.
- 6) **Road Dividers at Dunkin:** The Borough wants to submit a request to Penn Dot to add appropriate dividers that are desired for Dunkin. This will require us to remove the current dividers and submit pictures with the request. The Borough will leave it up to Penn Dot to decide rather these dividers are actually necessary to resolve the issue. The Borough will also request that an Officer sits in the parking lot in order to ticket drivers making illegal left hand turns.
- 7) **Round-A-Bout:** Kevin Miller spoke with Shane from Jackson Township to receive help. Shane is currently waiting on his manager to return for more information. Previous management did not apply for a full permit, this will take about 4-6 months to receive.
