#### **Public Comment**

Monique Hale expressed her interest in joining Council and gave a brief description of her experience. Council will decide.

Jeffrey Altland inquired about handicapped parking spots, approved by the Borough. He was told that they last for a year. Mr. Altland also advised the Borough that they do not have to approve handicapped parking spots because he believes residents are applying solely for the parking spot and not for an actual necessity. President Kevin March advised that he does not want to deny anyone who has a medical reason, signed by a doctor.

Teri Miller had concerns about snow removal, rental properties, and abandoned cars. Her issues are being addressed. Teri Miller also voiced concerns about issues that tenants are having. She was advised to have the tenants come in directly to make complaints.

Beverly Hilt spoke about the YMCA meeting last month and advised they are still expected to open on May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2026. She also advised that the YMCA would like to have two people from Spring Grove's Borough to be a part of their board, with one being an elected Council member. Beverly Hilt added that the Rail Trail Authority has received the funds needed to complete the next length of the trail. The Rail Trail Authority would like someone from the Borough to join their board, which could be an elected official or a resident. This board currently meets on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Tuesday of the month at Hanover Junction, at 1:00 PM.

### **Meeting Items**

1. **Veteran Banner Program:** Council discussed bringing back the Veteran Banner program, with twenty-five banners available for \$250 each.
2. **Borough's Engineer:** Tabled until next meeting.
3. **Water leak at Sewer Plant:** Council discussed needing to find the leak before it becomes a bigger issue. President Kevin March will talk this over more with Kevin Miller within the next few days.
4. **Halloween Parade and Christmas Tree Lighting Update:** Kristina Ruby met with Danielle Robinson and President Kevin March to explain that there were reserved funds from the first two years, which covered some expenses for the parade. Council agreed to keep these events and to restructure if needed.
5. **SEK:** Council discussed SEK: President Kevin March advises that they are still working with SEK to determine where they are able to assist.
6. **Saxton and Stump Program:** The dinner was rescheduled for February 24<sup>th</sup>, 2026, at 5:30 PM. The program will begin at 6:00 PM. This program is very educational, and council members will benefit from attending. Attendees must RSVP by February 10<sup>th</sup>, 2026.
7. **Furnace Replacement:** Council discussed the furnace replacement and will decide on a quote this week.
8. **Executive Session-Personnel:** Council went into executive session at 7:43 PM. Council came out of executive session at 8:20 PM.
